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17	RESPONDENT, FIRST PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH OF NEWARK dba	
18	PARKSIDE PRESCHOOL, having obtained the counsel of Sarah Jane Truong, has	
19	been fully advised of the charges of the Accusation in this matter (a copy of which is	
20	attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by reference), and hereby enter	
21	into the following Stipulation and Waiver; and Order ("Stipulation") with the	
22	COMPLAINANT, PAMELA DICKFOSS, as a means of achieving a full and final	
23	resolution of the Accusation in lieu of an evidentiary hearing and decision.	
24	Respondent and Complainant hereby stipulate and agree as follows:	
25	1. <u>FINDINGS</u> : Respondent admits the allegations in the Accusation and	
26	agrees that for purposes of this matter and all other matters between the Department

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and Respondent, the allegations of the Accusation are found to be true and to constitute a legally sufficient basis to revoke Respondent's license. Any admissions, implied, general or specific, do not constitute admissions for any other purpose or proceeding to which the Department is not a party, including third party civil, criminal, or administrative proceedings.

- REVOCATION OF LICENSE: Respondent's license is revoked upon the Department's adoption of this Stipulation as its Order.
- 3. FUTURE APPLICATION FOR A LICENSE, REGISTRATION, CERTIFICATION OR APPROVAL:
 - A. <u>Licensure, Certification or Approval</u>: Respondent shall not apply for, receive or hold, an administrator certificate or any license to operate, any facility licensed by the Department of Social Services including but not limited to any community care facility (CCF), certified family home (CFH), residential care facility for the elderly (RCFE), residential care facilities for persons with chronic, life-threatening illnesses (RCFCI), child day care facility (CDCF) or home care organization (HCO) (as CCF, CFH, RCFCI, RCFE, CDCF and HCO are defined in sections 1502(a), 1506(c), 1568, 1568.01, 1569.2, 1596.750, and 1796.37 of the Health and Safety Code) for a period of two (2) years from the effective date of the Stipulation and Order.
 - B. Application Denial: Respondent understands and agrees that the Department, Foster Family Agency or a county may deny any application for licensure, certification, registration or approval submitted in whole or in part based upon the findings in this Stipulation. However, Respondent understands that if the license, certification, registration or approval is denied by the Department or a county, Respondent shall be entitled to a hearing subject to the timely filing of an appeal to a notice of action, or the timely filing of a Notice of Defense after the Department has served Respondent with a Statement of Issues.

- 4. <u>WAIVER OF HEARING RIGHTS</u>: The parties waive their rights to a hearing to contest the allegations of the Accusation, to present any evidence on their behalf and to cross-examine witnesses testifying on the other party's behalf. The parties further waive their rights to further discovery in this matter.
- 5. WAIVER OF APPEAL/MODIFICATION RIGHTS: Respondent waives all rights of review arising out of this action or this Stipulation or the Order implementing it, including but not limited to a petition for reinstatement, reduction of penalty, or rehearing, reconsideration, writ of administrative mandamus, any other judicial or administrative review or any other right or ability Respondent may have to seek to have this Stipulation modified or set aside on any grounds whatsoever.
- 6. <u>WAIVER OF CLAIMS</u>: The parties waive all known or unknown legal actions or claims against each other, or their employees or agents, that they may have acquired or come to acquire arising out of this matter, with the following exceptions:
 - A. Civil penalties;
 - B. Monitoring fees; and
- C. Any action arising out of an audit or other review to establish, modify, preserve, enforce, or to recover an overpayment or to reimburse an underpayment of public or private funds.
- 7. <u>PUBLIC RECORD</u>: This Stipulation is a public record as required by section 11517(d) of the Government Code. It is accessible to the public pursuant to the Public Records Act, section 6250 <u>et seq.</u> of the Government Code.
- 8. <u>SIGNATURES</u>: All parties agree that a facsimile or scanned copy of the signature page of this Stipulation will bind the signing party or parties to the terms and conditions herein once any remaining party or parties execute the document and once the Order is executed.
 - 9. COUNTERPARTS: This Stipulation may be executed in counterparts.

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10. **EFFECTIVE DATE**: This Stipulation is effective on the date on which the Department's Order adopting it is executed.

11. NO ORAL MODIFICATION: This Stipulation constitutes the entire agreement between the parties with respect to the Accusation in this case. Moreover, the terms of this Stipulation may not be amended except in writing, signed by all the parties thereto.

12. REPRESENTATIONS RE: CORPORATE LICENSEE: Mike Marzano represents that he is the President of the Board of Trustees of Respondent. In entering into this Stipulation, Respondent represents that its Board of Trustees has reviewed the allegations contained in the Accusation and that in executing this Stipulation, Mike Marzano has authority to so act on behalf of Respondent.
